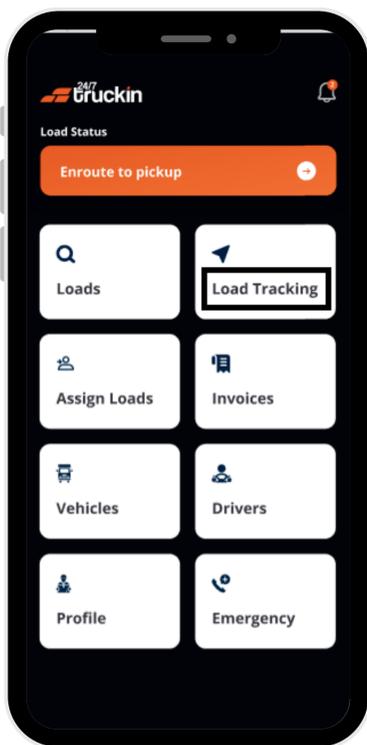
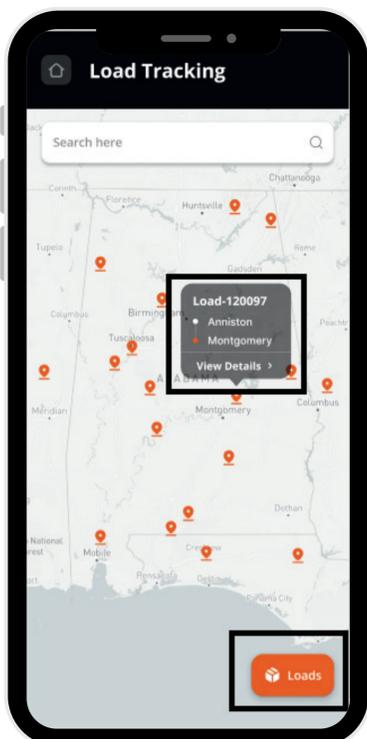


Image 2: Load Tracking Screen

Image 3: Active Loads Screen

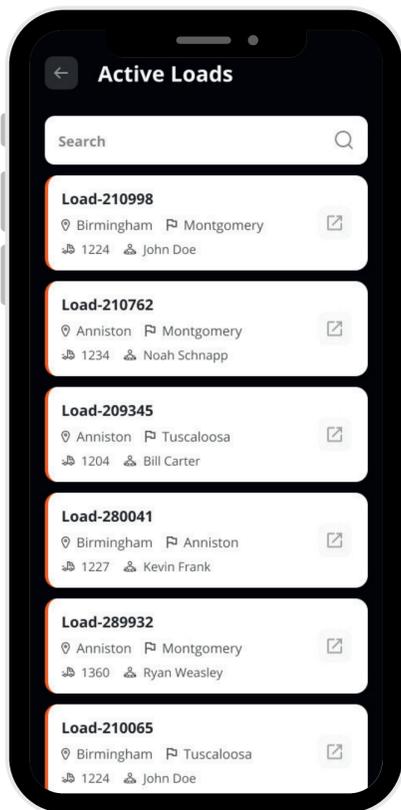
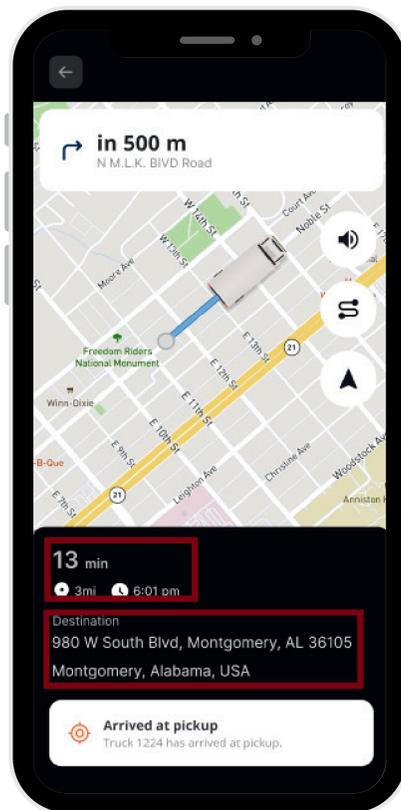


Image 4: Live Tracking of Truck Screen



b. Access Loads List:

- On the map screen displaying enroute loads, locate and tap on the "Loads" button located on the right side of the "bottom menu".
- A list of "all enroute loads" will appear.
- Select any "load card" from the list.
- A new screen will appear, showing the "live location" of the "truck" on the "map", along with "detailed load information".

5. Monitor Load Progress:

Utilize the "live tracking" feature to "monitor" the "progress" of "enroute loads" in "real-time". Keep track of the "driver's current location", "upcoming destination", and "estimated time" of "arrival" to ensure smooth load management and timely deliveries.

Image 5: Search Filter Screen

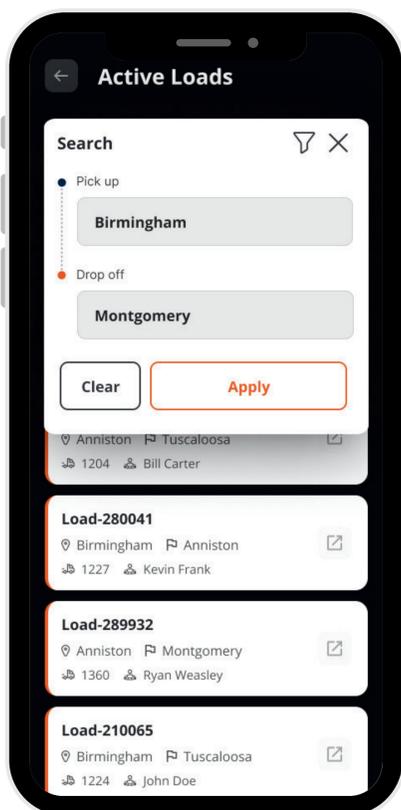
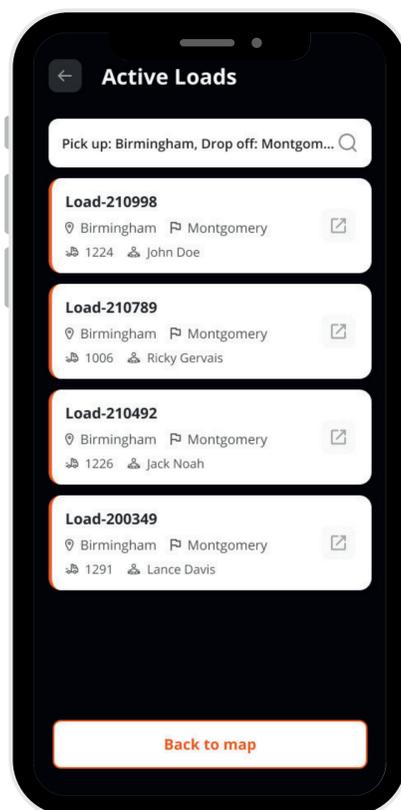


Image 6: Result Screen
