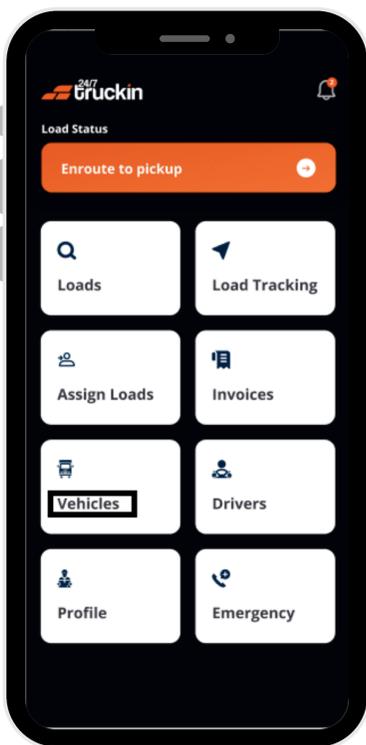
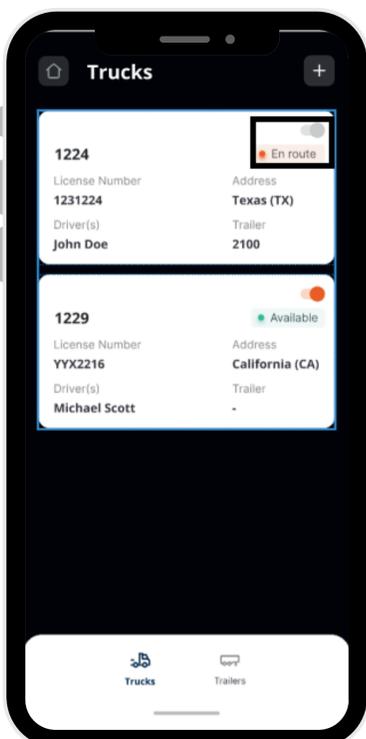


Image 2: Truck Screen



Follow these steps to Use Toggle Button on Truck:

1. Access the 24/7 Truckin Mobile Application:

3. View Truck Details:

- **Gray Toggle Button with "Unavailable" Status:** Indicates that the truck requires maintenance and repairs, rendering it unavailable for load assignments.

6. Take Action Based on Toggle Button Status:

- If the "Toggle Button" is "orange" and the "truck" is "available", you can proceed to "assign loads", "drivers", "trailer", "set location", and "edit details" as needed.
- If the "Toggle Button" is "gray" and the "truck status" is "Unavailable," it signifies that "maintenance" or "repairs" are required. In this case, refrain from assigning any "loads to the truck", as it is temporarily out of service.

7. Manage Unavailable Trucks:

For trucks marked as unavailable, owner-operators have limited functionalities. They can only delete the truck from the application to remove it from their fleet management.

The Toggle Button feature provides owner-operators with crucial insights into the status of their trucks, allowing them to make informed decisions regarding load assignments and fleet management.
