

How the Notification Panel Works for Drivers on the 24/7 Truckin App


Stay Informed with Instant Updates



Overview:

The Notification Panel in the 24/7 Truckin app helps drivers stay updated on their assignments in real time. Notifications are sent when an Owner Operator assigns or removes them from tasks. These notifications are stored in the Notification Panel, allowing you to view them anytime.

Steps are as follow:

1. Open the 24/7 Truckin App

- Launch the app on your mobile device.

2. Go to the Notification Panel

- On the homepage, tap the "Notifications icon".
- The "Notification Panel" will display all your notifications in chronological order.

Types of Notifications

- 1. Truck Assigned:** Sent when an Owner Operator "assigns a truck" to the driver.
- 2. Trailer Assigned:** Sent when an Owner Operator "assigns a trailer" to the driver.
- 3. Load Assigned:** Sent when an Owner Operator "assigns a load" to the driver.
- 4. Load Pickup Reminder:** Sent as a reminder about the "scheduled load pickup".




Image 3: Load Assigned Screen




Image 4: View Load Screen




Image 5: Truck Assigned Screen




Image 6: Trailer Assign Screen




Image 7: Profile Screen




Image 8: Load Removal Screen




Image 9: Load Reminder Screen




Image 10: Truck Removal Screen





Image 11: Trailer Removal Screen



5. Truck Assignment Removed: Sent when an Owner Operator "removes the driver" from the truck assignment.

6. Trailer Assignment Removed: Sent when an Owner Operator "removes the driver" from the trailer assignment.

7. Load Assignment Removed: Sent when an Owner Operator "removes the driver" from the load assignment.

By following above steps, drivers can stay on top of their tasks and assignments via the Notification Panel on the 24/7 Truckin app.
